On 9th January, 2024, the above described colt was examined by me at the Magic Millions Sale Complex, Ascot Court, Bundall, Qld.

- A neat, compact, athletic colt with nice medium hindquarter. He walked well, hand-held on the lead in the parade area on the sale complex with good action. He was subject to normal passive flexion tests with no abnormality noted. Joints and tendons are tight to palpation. All conformation and clinical parameters were within normal limits. Two testes were palpated.
- This examination is within the limits of examining an unbroken yearling, at hand, in the paddock/sale ground environment.
- X-rays (repository series, taken by me: Central Coast Equine Practice) were available and examined by me previously in the repository.
 - These were considered to be: **“Low risk”**.
- Endoscopy examinations:
 - Pre-Sale: I viewed the pre-sale repository video and graded as: **“Grade 1”**
 - Post-Sale: Done separately, done through the Magic Millions sale office
 - **“Pass Conditions of Sale”**, see separate report.

This exam and report is limited to the conformation and clinical inspection noted herein.

Conclusion: At the time of this examination, the colt **“Precious Lorraine / Dundee 2022”** is, in so far as can be determined from the examination conducted, suitable for syndication for racing and as such is furthermore suitable for all risk mortality insurance cover.
